About Senior's Program

Senior's Program is a fortnightly program that seeks to provide our Year 6 students with an enriched learning experience to develop skills that will benefit them beyond their primary years.





We don't charge more than the price of a casual booking for learners to attend (with the exception of Mystery Tour).

The Rules



Parent Obligations & Rules

1. You are legally required to sign your child in and out for each day. You may pick up your child from the excursion – however the educators will need to be notified prior to the excursion day in order to make the necessary adjustments.

2. If you do not want your child to participate in any particular activity that your child is attending, you must notify us in writing via email.

3. Please ensure that if you child has any dietary requirements or preferences, these are communicated prior to the excursion so that we can cater for your child when possible, otherwise please provide adequate food for your child.

4. Parents with considerable outstanding debt may have their child excluded from Senior's Program activities.

Children's Obligations & Rules

1. Unless specified, students must wear the Jamboree Height's SS uniform, enclosed shoes and are required to bring a hat if the activity has any outdoor element.

2. Unless specified, phones, devices and toys are not to be brought on excursions. In the event they are, they are the responsibility of the child. Misuse will result in confiscation.

3. Some excursions may require students to bring money or GoCards. These are the responsibility of the student and **not** the educators attending.

4. Inappropriate, disrespectful or any behaviour that may negatively portray the school or places people (including the student) at risk of safety, will result in the student being excluded from Senior's Program.

<u>Mystery Tour</u>

Each year in Term 4 we operate *Mystery Tour,* an exciting night packed full of excursions and good times to celebrate their time at OSHC. JHOSHC are the <u>only</u> OSHC in Australia to offer this kind of experience, so we only take students who earn the privilege.

To attend Mystery Tour, students must **attend a minimum** of 10 Senior's Programs throughout the year **or** regularly attend OSHC.

Year 6 students who do not act in safely, responsibly or respectfully both at OSHC and during Senior's Program may be excluded from Mystery Tour.





When does Senior's Program run?

A: Senior's Program operates fortnightly. Usually 5 times per term, with a mix of BSC and ASC session activities.

What do you do on Senior's Program?

A: Lots of fun things! From catching the bus to the shops, to smashing stuff, to having brekkie before school. We try cover a range of exciting experiences. Lookout for the Term Outline that is emailed to you or check it out at <u>www.jhoshc.com.au/program</u>.

How do I arrange for my child to attend?

A: Each Term, lookout for an email that has our program outline. It will have a link to an online permission form that you can complete. Once that's done, book them in for the session and we'll look after the rest!

Why is the cost a casual booking?

A: Whilst we do not charge an additional fee, we charge the casual booking cost to cover the extra cost of staffing. Note for activities like Brekkie at the local Café, your child will need to bring their own money to purchase food.

How many other Year 6's usually attend?

A: We usually average between 15 and 30 Year 6's depending on the date of the activity and size of the Year 6 cohort.

My child doesn't attend OSHC usually - can they still attend?

A: Of course! Provided you have an active enrolment, and we have enough space for the children to attend, they are welcome to attend.

What happens in the event of rain?

A: During wet weather, activities will be conducted onsite with food provided unless otherwise stipulated or communicated.

My child has a disability / injury / allergy / other that I am worried will limit their ability to participate.

A: Our staff are incredibly accommodating and happy to work with you & your child to ensure they can benefit from our Senior's Program activities just as much as anyone else.
